G.B.H. Terry appears on sale bill of estate of Grandfather, John Terry, December 16th, 1834 Chester, SC. -- Apt 67, Pkg 1050.

Headstone for Green B. H. Terry George's Chapel Cemetery a cemetery for Methodist Episcopal Church South located 2 miles south of New London, Union Co., AR and 4 miles north of Strong AR and east of the Strong-New London Road in Section 11-18-12. Headstone for wife of G.B.H. Terry, George's Chapel Cemetery, New London, Union Co., AR. Inscription reads: Eleanor, wife of G. B. H. Terry b Jan 20, 1811 d Oct 5, 1861. A picture of the headstone is in possession of Robert M. Terry, 15537 S. 289th E Ave, Coweta OK 74429

Stephen Terry and Eleanor Gill mentioned as parents of George W. Terry, their son, in Goodspeed History of Southern Arkansas: Nevada Co., AR p. 587. Notes G.B.H. Terry b SC d 22 Mar 1848 and Eleanor (Gill) Terry b SC d 5 Oct 1861.

George W. Terry indicated in same article that family moved from GA in 1847.

Green B.H. Terry noted as son of Major Stephen Terry in Will of Stephen Terry signed March 1866 and probated Nov 22, 1866 in State of GA, Fulton Co.
