Dear Mother i once more embrace the oportunity of sending you a few lines to let you know that wee are all well at this time hoping thes lines my fined you enjoying like blessing i received a letter from sister Sarah and Deborah yesterday i was glad to hear that you was all well but sorry that i disappointed you by not going there it was occaissonially sickness Asberry and Nancy went to South Carolina and their children took the fever i thought they would Die and i Did not like to leave winny in such Distress and then 2 of our children took it but none Died i then took a trip to Arkansas but i did not buy land i did not get through the swamp i Dont know where i shall move to. i dont think i can stay here verrylong tell Aley that Hannah and Charles is well or was when i last heard from them they live 10 miles from us they are Doing tolerbly well he is carrying onafarm and a sort of Apothacary shop the have 5 children 4 girls and 1 boy Winny has 8 4 boys and 4 girls they are all well at this time wee got a letter from Harrison and letty about 2 months ago they was all well then he said he was a going to move to Alabama this fall to Talladega County it has been verry Dry there this year crops was cut short there i suppose crops is tolerbly good here this year corn is selling at \$1 per bushel pork \$3 per hundred bacon 4½ butter 12½ per lb eggs 12 ½ per dozen wheat 75 cent per bushel cotton from 4 to 5 per hundred at memphes i want you to rite to me soon i Dont know when i can go to see you i will go when i get the chance i must bring my letter to a close by wishing to be remembered to all enquireing friends
